Highlights

- 1. Briefly describes the organization
- 2. Explains HOW the organization was beneficial to them and what they gained from the experience
- 3. Gives detailed examples of aspects from the program that helped them grow as a person (i.e. improved public speaking skills)
- 4. Concludes the essay by redirecting the focus back to themselves and how the experience changed them

Do's

- 1. SAR statements
 - a. Situation, action, result
- 2. Revert your topic back to you
 - a. Refer back to the example essay
- 3. Know it is okay to boast yourself up
- 4. Write about something you are *passionate* about

Don't

- 1. Take up too many words talking about an organization/other people
 - a. Briefly describe the organization or another person, but do not make the essay all about them
- 2. Scratch any ideas that you may have
 - a. No idea is a bad idea!
 - i. Free write with any thought/ idea you may have in case you come back to it
- 3. Assume something is too personal
 - a. Write about what you're comfortable sharing, but also take risks

- 3. Start brainstorming one for each
